2005 - 2006 WSYSA TOURNAMENT HOSTING AGREEMENT

(Addendum to U S Youth Soccer Tournament/Games Hosting Agreement)

In consideration of permission being granted to Emerald City (Host Association) to hold a tournament at 60 Hwy (city) on the dates of July 5-8 2005 ~~2006~~, we hereby agree that as the Tournament Host Organization we will, in addition to the US Soccer Hosting Agreement, abide by the following:

CREDENTIAL CHECKS

We agree that we shall conduct credential checks to ensure that:

1. All players are registered with U S Soccer or other affiliated organizations (ex: AYSO, USYS, YMCA).
2. All out of state and foreign teams present approved application to travel from the appropriate authority.
 - (a) Out of state teams must have their State Organization Member approval.
 - (b) All foreign teams must show USYS approval as well as approval from their Federation Organization Member.
3. All foreign team players must present picture identification cards issued by the team's Federation Organization Member

POST TOURNAMENT REPORT

We agree that we shall file a Tournament Report with the National State Association granting us permission to host this tournament, within thirty (30) days of the conclusion of the tournament. We understand that failure to file the report shall preclude the tournament host from receiving sanction for the following seasonal year until the report is filed. The Tournament Report shall include the following information:

1. The number of teams participating in each age division.
2. The name of the champion for each division, if a champion is determined.
3. If "Sportsmanship Awards" are given, indicate the criteria for the award and to whom they were given.
4. The number of fields used for the tournament.
5. The name of the tournament sponsor, if any.

DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

We hereby agree to the following conditions:

- 1. **ABIDE BY RULES** - We shall abide by all statements made in our Application to Host a Tournament or Games, in our tournament invitation, in our tournament rules, and in this U.S. SOCCER International Tournament/Games Hosting Agreement. We agree that all decisions regarding acceptance of teams into a tournament shall be fairly and impartially made and shall not be based upon race, creed, color, national origin, or national affiliation.
- 2. **INVITATIONS** - The tournament approval form shall accompany all tournament invitations distributed by us.
- 3. **PROCURING LIABILITY INSURANCE** - We have procured liability insurance coverage for the tournament or games with limits not less than \$100,000/\$200,000/\$25,000 which names the U. S. Soccer Member with which the Host Organization is affiliated any affiliate organization where the host organization is a member, U. S. Soccer and their officers and directors as additional insureds. A certificate of insurance is attached issued by WSSA.
- 4. **REQUIRING MEDICAL AUTHORIZATIONS** - We shall require all teams participating in the tournament or games to provide notarized medical authorizations for each player in a form adequate for use at the site of the tournament. These authorizations shall be presented to the Host Organization at registration and kept at the field available for use by the team.
- 5. **AMATEUR SPORTS ACT** - We have read and agree to abide by the provisions of the Ted Stevens Olympic and Amateur Sports Act (see below).
- 6. **ADVANCE PUBLICATION OF RULES** - We agree that our tournament or games rules shall be included with the invitation sent to each team and shall again, be published to all teams accepted, prior to the start of the tournament.
- 7. **USE OF FIELD MARSHALS/FIELD INSPECTION** - We agree that during the tournament each game field will have a field marshal assigned to it at all times; that the field marshal will be readily available and identifiable; that prior to the commencement of every game the field marshal will inspect the field to be sure that it is free from objects or conditions that may cause injury. - 10. **AVAILABILITY OF POLICE AND RESCUE SERVICE** - We have notified the local police, ambulance and emergency rescue services of the date of the tournament or games and the times and fields which will be used for games, and have been advised by them that they will be available to render assistance if needed.
- 11. **TOURNAMENT RULES/BEHAVIOR** - We agree that our tournament or games rules contain provisions ensuring that the behavior of teams, players, coaches and spectators is appropriately controlled including specific provisions:
 - a. which spell out the disciplinary measures to be imposed for the issuances of red and yellow cards or other improper conduct;
 - b. which indicate what procedures will be followed regarding protests and appeals;
 - c. which indicate that all disciplinary measures imposed by host organizations shall be limited to placing restrictions upon an individual's group participation in the tournament or games;

TED STEVENS OLYMPIC AND AMATEUR SPORTS ACT

§220525. Granting sanctions for amateur athletic competitions

- (a) PROMPT REVIEW AND DECISION.—For the sport that it governs, a national governing body promptly shall—
- (1) review a request by an amateur sports organization or person for a sanction to hold an international amateur athletic competition in the United States or to sponsor United States amateur athletes to compete in international amateur athletic competition outside the United States; and
 - (2) grant the sanction if—
 - (A) the national governing body does not decide by clear and convincing evidence that holding or sponsoring an international amateur athletic competition would be detrimental to the best interest of the sport; and
 - (B) the requirements of subsection (b) of this section are met
- (b) REQUIREMENTS.—An amateur sports organization or person may be granted a sanction under this section only if the organization or person meets the following requirements—
- (1) The organization or person must pay the national governing body any required sanctioning fee, if the fee is reasonable and nondiscriminatory.
 - (2) For a sanction to hold an international amateur athletic competition in the United States, the organization or person must—
 - (A) submit to the national governing body an audited or notarized financial report of similar events, if any, conducted by the organization or person; and
 - (B) demonstrate that the requirements of paragraph (4) of this subsection have been met.
 - (3) For a sanction to sponsor United States amateur athletes to compete in international amateur athletic competition outside the United States, the organization or person must—
 - (A) submit a report of the most recent trip to a foreign country, if any, that the organization or person sponsored for the purpose of having United States amateur athletes compete in international amateur athletic competition; and
 - (B) submit a letter from the appropriate entity that will hold the international amateur athletic competition certifying that the requirements of paragraph (4) of this subsection have been met.
 - (4) The requirements referred to in paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection are that—
 - (A) appropriate measures have been taken to protect the amateur status of athletes who will take part in the competition and to protect their eligibility to compete in amateur athletic competition;
 - (B) appropriate provision has been made for validation of any records established during the competition;
 - (C) due regard has been given to any international amateur athletic requirements specifically applicable to the competition;
 - (D) the competition will be conducted by qualified officials;
 - (E) proper medical supervision will be provided for athletes who will participate in the competition; and
 - (F) proper safety precautions have been taken to protect the personal welfare of the athletics and spectators at the competition.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. The Tournament Committee shall be the final authority in all tournament matters.
2. Matches shall be played in conformity with the rules of WSYSA, USYSA, and FIFA, unless otherwise stated herein.
3. All non-Washington State teams must have official player identification passes issued by their state, Provincial or National Association. All teams should have the official Tournament roster forms, including players name, birthdates and jersey number, signed and approved by their Association or League registrar. Out-of-state Teams must also have the proper permission to travel papers from their State, Provincial or National authorities.
4. All teams must have their travel papers, player identification cards and official team roster verified and approved by the Tournament Registrar. This may be done at the pre-tournament check-in or at the Tournament field headquarters no less than one hour prior to the teams first match. There will be no exceptions.
5. State or Provincial Select or Development teams may only take part at the discretion of the Tournament Committee in the age division assigned by the Tournament Committee. Such teams will always play in a division at least one year older than they normally would.
6. Each team is limited to a roster of 18 players. Team may have guest players with proper identification. No player may participate on more than one team playing in the tournament.
7. All teams will play a minimum of three matches.
8. Each division shall be limited to no more than sixteen teams. When possible, divisions shall be divided into equal sized groups, with teams playing matches against every other team in their group. Groups shall be seeded and, when possible, drawn to avoid placement of teams from the same area in the same group.
9. A point system shall be employed to determine the order of finish in group play, as follows.
 - Six points for a win.
 - One point per goal up to three goals
 - One point for a shutout.
 - Three points shall be awarded for a draw
 - The team with the most points in Group Play will be the winner of the Group; the rest of the teams shall finish in the order of most point.If teams are equal in points, then tie-breakers, in order of importance, shall be:
 - The team which defeated the other.
 - Total goals against.
 - The team with the fewest losses in group play.
 - The team which posted the most opponent shut-outs (opponents held scoreless)
 - The team scoring the most goals.
 - Coin Toss or Penalty Kicks
10. The duration of matches shall be as follows:
 - Group play, Consolation and Semi-Finals matches:

U-11	50 minutes	two 25 minute halves
U-12,13,14,15,16,17	60 minutes	two 30 minute halves
U-19	90 minutes	two 45 minute halves
 - Championship Finals:

U-11	50 minutes	two 25 minute halves
U-12,13,14,15,16,17	60 minutes	two 30 minute halves
U-19	90 minutes	two 45 minute halves

In group Play and Consolation matches, draw shall stand as played. In the Semi-Finals and Finals, matches which end in a draw shall be decided by the playing of extra time. In divisions U-11 through U-19 (2 x 10 Minute over time) and shall **play golden goal**, if still tied, and then the match is decided by the taking kicks from the mark.

11. Every team must have two sets of uniforms: dark and light jerseys. When the color of the team shirts conflict, the team listed first in the schedule must change to an alternate color.
12. Substitution shall be allowed as follows:
 1. Prior to a throw-in, in your favor
 2. Prior to a goal kick, by either Team
 3. After a goal, by either team
 4. After an injury, when the referee stops play, by either team
 5. at half time
 6. When the referee stops play to caution a player, only the cautioned player may be substituted, prior to the restart of the game
 7. Unlimited substitutions
 8. A cautioned player shall be substituted for immediately and not return until the next legal substitution.
13. If a player is sent off, that player and his or her coach **must report** to the Tournament Judicial Committee within minutes of the end of the match. If the offense is of a serious nature, the Tournament Committee reserves the right to impose a suspension. Should a player be sent off a second time, the Tournament Judicial Committee may suspend the player for the remainder of the tournament? If any player receives three yellow cards during the tournament, he or she will sit out a game suspension and that player and his or her coach must report to the Tournament Committee within 30 minutes of the match in which the third yellow card is given.
14. All appeals of misconduct reports shall be made in writing, and the game referee must be Notified before he or she leaves the field. The appeal must be submitted to the Tournament Field Headquarters no more than 30 minutes after the completion of the match. The appeal must detail the errors which the referee may have committed, and include any other mitigating circumstances and third testimony that should be considered. Appeals will be settled by the Tournament Judicial Committee.
15. All games are FINAL. NO protests are accepted, decision on the field is final. Coaches are held strictly accountable for the conduct of their teams, parents and supporters. Abusive behavior toward the referee, opponents or tournament staff will not be tolerated. Such misconduct and breaches of sportsmanship shall be turned over to the Tournament Judicial for the immediate hearing.
16. Neither the Tournament Committee, Nor LWYSA are responsible for games cancelled because of unplayable fields. Such cancellations are for the safety of the players and referee's and no liability will be assumed.
17. WSYSA now allows casts.
